

Lotte Köhler Prize for Psychoanalytic Developmental, Cultural and Social Psychology

For the second time, the *Hans Kilian and Lotte Köhler Center for Social and Cultural Psychology and Historical Anthropology* (KKC) at the Ruhr-University Bochum and the *Sigmund Freud Institute* (SFI) in Frankfurt am Main are awarding the biannual

Lotte Köhler Prize for Psychoanalytic Developmental, Cultural and Social Psychology

The prize will be awarded in honour of Dr. Lotte Köhler's scientific achievements as well as her outstanding commitment as founder of the Köhler Foundation and benefactor of psychoanalytic and psychological research. In addition to personally conducting numerous research projects in the above-mentioned fields and promoting groundbreaking contributions by other scholars, she has significantly supported international psychoanalytic exchange and strengthened the discipline's reputation through her diverse activities over several decades.

The Lotte Köhler Prize will be awarded in two categories:

a) The prize winner in the main category will receive a cash prize in the amount of 3,000 euros. Eligible nominees must have significantly contributed to the profile and dissemination of psychoanalytical, developmental, cultural or social-psychological research on human development. Their fundamental and lasting contribution will usually consist of several publications and additional academic contributions (e.g., development of a research program, merits in teaching or institutionalisation of psychoanalytic and/or cultural psychological development research).

b) The winner of the Young Researcher Award will receive a cash prize in the amount of 2,000 euros for an individual piece of work in the form of an outstanding dissertation or master's thesis.

The official award ceremony will take place on June 20, 2024 at 4 p.m.
